#### **ABOUT THE WORK**

Dances on the Choreographic Honors Edition 2007 series have been created by Juilliard choreographers and are selected from the following sources of work:

Composition I is taught by Elizabeth Keen with musician Reed Hansen. The course explores essential elements of choreography: the use of space, time, and dynamics, as well as movement qualities, invention, thematic development and shaping the total form. The dances shown on these programs are either interactive duets that investigate connection, or solos created in collaboration with a musician.

Composition II is taught by JoAnna Mendl Shaw with musician Jerome Begin. Class assignments investigate personal signature as reflected in choice of choreographic form, intent of work, development of phrase material, and use of sound/music. Dances created are solo, duet and group works for three or more dancers.

Senior Production class has a two-fold mandate. All the dances are choreographed by seniors who have shown choreographic promise and growth through their previous three years at school. The entire senior class is then responsible for producing the concert in which these dances are presented. The program serves as a bridge to the professional world, and as such, the choreographers work within set time and budgetary constraints. These dances are presented in April at the Clark Studio Theater in the Rose Building. The seniors are mentored by Risa Steinberg and Aaron Landsman. The Junior Class, under the supervision of Stan Pressner, is responsible for all technical aspects of this production.

Independent Projects are developed outside of the class structure.
