

Under the artistic direction of Lawrence Rhodes since 2002, Juilliard Dance aims to create true contemporary dancers, trained equally in classical ballet and modern dance. Established in 1951 by William Schuman during his tenure as president of The Juilliard School, with the guidance of founding division director Martha Hill, Juilliard became the first major teaching institution to combine equal

instruction in both contemporary and ballet techniques.

Juilliard Dance aims to create true contemporary dancers, trained equally in classical ballet and modern dance.

Each year 24 new dancers are accepted into the four-year BFA program. In addition to daily ballet and modern technique classes, every dancer participates in classical and contemporary partnering, dance composition, anatomy, acting, dance history, stagecraft, production, music theory, repertory, and elements of performing. Dancers are encouraged to present their own choreographed works in informal concerts and workshop presentations. In addition, each fall, every class has the opportunity to work with established choreographers in premiere dances as part of today's New Dances performances. Recent commissions include works by Kyle Abraham, Aszure Barton, Zvi Gotheiner, Larry Keigwin, Loni Landon, Austin McCormick, Helen Simoneau, and Kate Weare. Spring performances give dancers the opportunity to perform in established works from repertory. Recent repertory performances included works by Pina Bausch, Merce Cunningham, Nacho Duato, William Forsythe, Martha Graham, Jiří Kylián, José Limón, Mark Morris, Jerome Robbins, Paul Taylor, and Twyla Tharp.

Juilliard Dance alumni include, among others, the choreographers and directors Robert Battle, Pina Bausch, Lar Lubovitch, Ohad Naharin, and Paul Taylor. Juilliard dancers are currently dancing in Nederlands Dans Theater, Nederlands Dans Theater 2, Les Grands Ballets Canadiens de Montréal, BJM Danse, L.A. Dance Project, Mark Morris Dance Group, Hubbard Street Dance Chicago, San Francisco Ballet, Kidd Pivot, and Batsheva Dance Company, among many others, as well as several Broadway productions.

The Juilliard Dance Division is the proud recipient of the 2015 Capezio Award, and is the first educational institution to receive the honor. (juilliard.edu/dance)

### About the Artists

### Lawrence Rhodes

Ballet master and master teacher Lawrence Rhodes was appointed artistic director of the Juilliard Dance Division in July 2002. Mr. Rhodes began his career with the Ballet Russe de Monte Carlo, and performed as a principal dancer with the Joffrey Ballet, Harkness Ballet, and Pennsylvania Ballet. He was also permanent guest artist at Het Nationale Ballet, while also dancing with the Eliot Feld Ballet and in Italy with Carla Fracci. After his first non-performing role as teacher and chairman of the dance department at New York University, Mr. Rhodes spent a decade as artistic director of Les Grands Ballets Canadiens de Montréal. He received a 2008 Dance Magazine award and a 2009 Dance Teacher Magazine lifetime achievement award for his outstanding work in the industry. Mr. Rhodes is a frequent guest teacher in Europe and has adjudicated for several major international dance competitions.



### John Heginbotham

Originally from Anchorage, Alaska, John Heginbotham is a Brooklyn-based choreographer, performer, and teacher. He graduated from Juilliard in 1993 with a BFA in dance and was a member of the Mark Morris Dance Group from 1998 to 2012. In 2014, Mr. Heginbotham was awarded the Jacob's Pillow Dance Award in recognition of his unique choreographic vision and promise. He is also a two-time recipient of the Jerome Robbins Foundation New Essential Works fellowship (2010, 2012). In addition to his work with Dance Heginbotham, his choreography has been performed at venues including the Museum of Modern Art, Joe's Pub at the Public Theater, Dance Theater Workshop, and at the New York and Toronto Fringe festivals, among others. Mr. Heginbotham is a founding teacher of Dance for PD, an ongoing collaboration between the Mark Morris Dance Group and the Brooklyn Parkinson Group. (danceheginbotham.org)





### Katarzyna Skarpetowska

Katarzyna Skarpetowska is a native of Warsaw, Poland. She is a graduate of New York City's LaGuardia High School of Music & Art and Performing Arts and received a BFA from Juilliard in 1999. In 1992, she performed on Broadway in Metro, directed by Janusz Jozefowicz. Ms. Skarpetowska was a member of Parsons Dance from 1999 to 2006, where she performed lead roles in the company's repertory including Parsons' iconic Caught. She danced for the Lar Lubovitch Dance Company from 2007 to 2014 (performing at theaters including New York's City Center, the Kennedy Center, and Moscow's Bolshoi Theater) and currently serves as the company's repetiteur. She has also been a quest artist with the Battleworks Dance Company and Buglisi Dance Theater. Named one of Dance Magazine's 25 to watch in 2016, her choreography has been performed by Richmond Ballet, Ailey II, Lar Lubovitch Dance Company, Parsons Dance, Buglisi Dance Theater, Houston METdance, Hubbard Street 2, and Bruce Wood Dance Project, among others. ### Pam Tanowitz

Pam Tanowitz has been making dances since 1992. She founded Pam Tanowitz Dance in 2000 and has received commissions and residencies at the Joyce Theater, Vail International Dance Festival, City Center's Fall for Dance festival, Lincoln Center Out of Doors, New York Live Arts, the Kitchen, Danspace Project, the Guggenheim Museum's Works and Process program, Baryshnikov Arts Center, and Bard's Summerscape festival. Ms. Tanowitz was awarded a Guggenheim fellowship in 2011, a 2013–14 Hodder fellowship from Princeton University, and has received two Bessie Awards, in 2009 and 2016. She has choreographed works for Juilliard, Barnard College, Princeton University, Mason Gross School of the Arts at Rutgers University, Marymount Manhattan College, and Purchase College; and has set works on Ballet Austin, New York Theatre Ballet, and Saint Louis Ballet. Ms. Tanowitz is resident fellow at N.Y.U.'s Center for Ballet and the Arts, is a 2016-17 New York City Center Choreography fellow, and a member of the faculty at Rutgers University. She holds dance degrees from Ohio State University and Sarah Lawrence College. (pamtanowitzdance.org)

### Matthew Neenan

Matthew Neenan began his dance training at the Boston Ballet School and later attended New York's LaGuardia High School of Music & Art and Performing Arts and the School of American Ballet. From 1994 to 2007 he danced with the Pennsylvania Ballet, appearing in numerous principal roles. In 2005 he co-founded BalletX with dancer Christine Cox. The company is currently the resident dance company at the Wilma Theater in Philadelphia and has toured nationally and internationally with Mr. Neenan's work, including appearances at the Vail International Dance Festival, Jacob's Pillow Dance Festival, New York City Center, Laguna Dance Festival, and the Joyce Theater. In 2007 he was named choreographer in residence for Pennsylvania Ballet. Mr. Neenan's choreography has been performed by ballet companies including the Washington Ballet, Ballet West, Tulsa Ballet, Colorado Ballet, Ballet Memphis, Milwaukee Ballet and Ballet Met. He has received awards and grants from the National Endowment of the Arts, Dance Advance funded by the Pew Charitable Trusts, Choo San Goh Foundation, New York Choreographic Institute Fellowship Initiative, and was the first recipient of the Jerome Robbins Foundation's New Essential Works (NEW) Fellowship Grant. ### Clifton Taylor

Lighting designer Clifton Taylor has been associated with the Juilliard School as a designer for the dance and opera divisions since 1995. In that time, he has worked on the creation of many new works and revivals of classic pieces from the dance repertory. Mr. Taylor also designs for opera, dance, and theater companies around the world. His designs have been commissioned for Broadway and by companies ranging from American Ballet Theatre and Alvin Ailey to Karole Armitage, Lar Lubovitch, and the San Francisco Ballet, to name a few. This year he has collaborated on new works in nine countries outside of the U.S. He is committed to arts education and to supporting the work of performing artists here at Juilliard and at other schools with which he has long associations such as the Royal University of Fine Arts in Cambodia, the Hartt School in Connecticut, New York University, and Casa Richter in Southern Chile.
